Orange County, FL

> Over 1.2 million residents

• White: 68.7%

Hispanic or Latino: 29.8%

Black or African American: 22.3%

Asian: 5.6%

American Indian and Alaskan Native: 0.6%

Native Hawaiian and other Pacific Islander: 0.2%

Foreign born persons: 19.7%

> Over 63 million annual tourist visits





Epidemiology Program

- Florida Department of Health in Orange County (DOH-Orange)

- Investigate Diseases and Outbreaks/Clusters
 - 3,500 diseases
 - 40 outbreaks
- High-risk Investigations
 - MERS
 - Ebola



Electronic Surveillance System for the Early Notification of Community-based Epidemics (ESSENCE-FL)












Prioritization

- Determine a capture radius based on hypothesized tourist activity
- Plot radii on each of the predetermined major points of interest
- Identify HC facilities that are not reporting to ESSENCE-FL
- Identify HC facilities that are part of a chain and lie within the parameters of interest
- Identify HC facilities that serve Medicaid patients
- Consider length of time HC facility established
- Consider hours of operation



Next Steps

- Target and recruit facilities for enrollment in ESSENCE-FL
 - State and local effort
