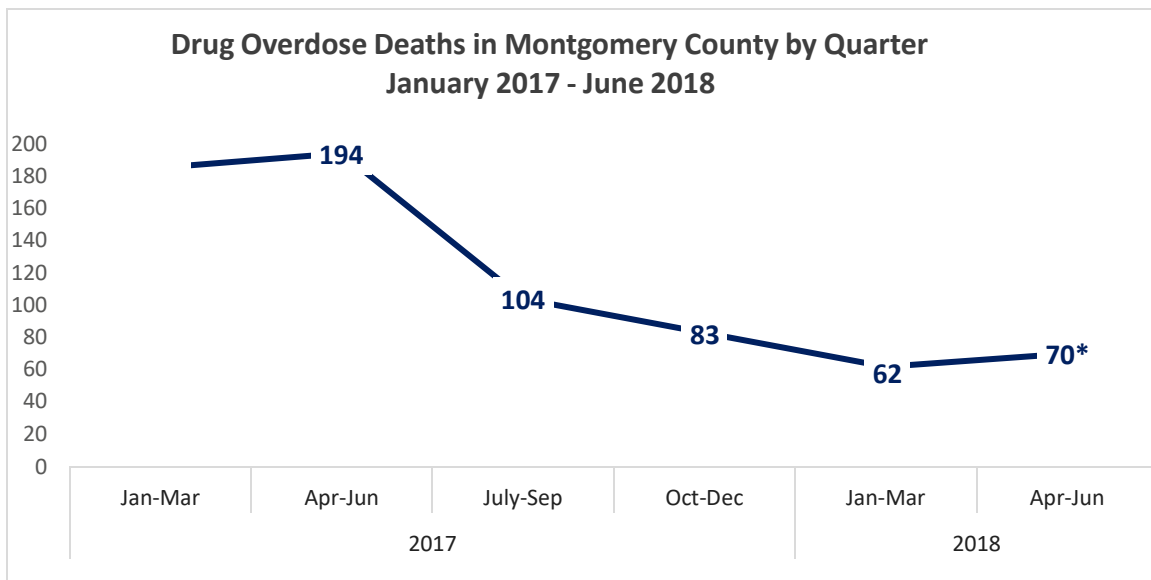
**Overdose Trends
January 2017 – June 2018**

The following indicators show a decrease in overdoses between the first six months of 2017 and the same period in 2018. Each of these decreases is by 60% or more.

Drug Overdose Deaths	↓65% Overdose
Emergency Department Visits	↓73% Law
Enforcement Overdose Calls	↓66%
EMS Overdose Runs	↓68% Naloxone
Doses Administered by EMS	↓60%

Drug Overdose Deaths, January 1 – June 30

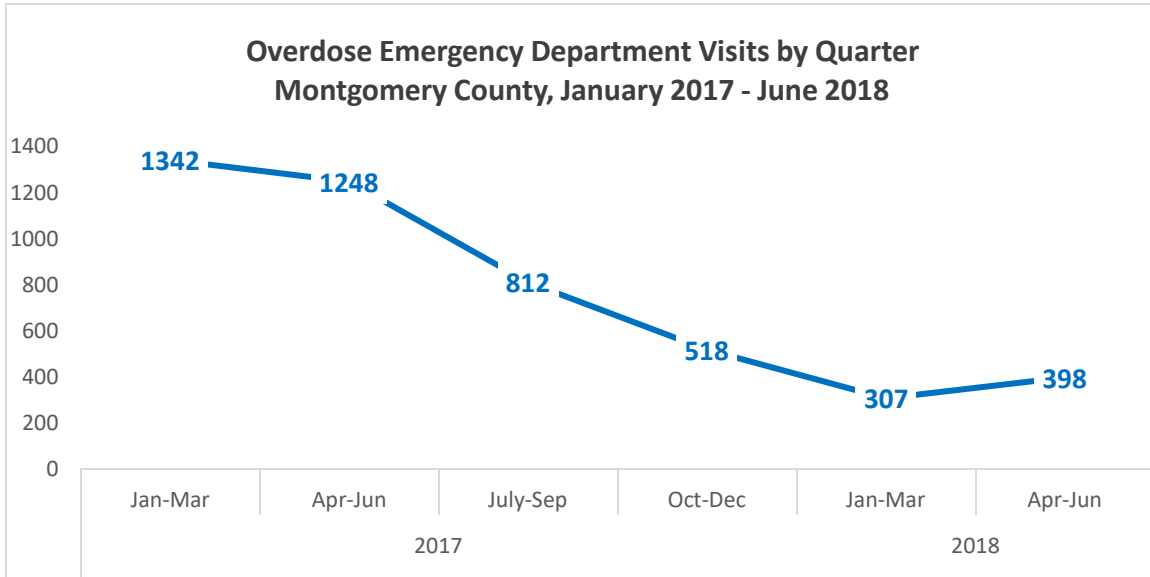

Overdose Emergency Department Visits, January 1 – June 30

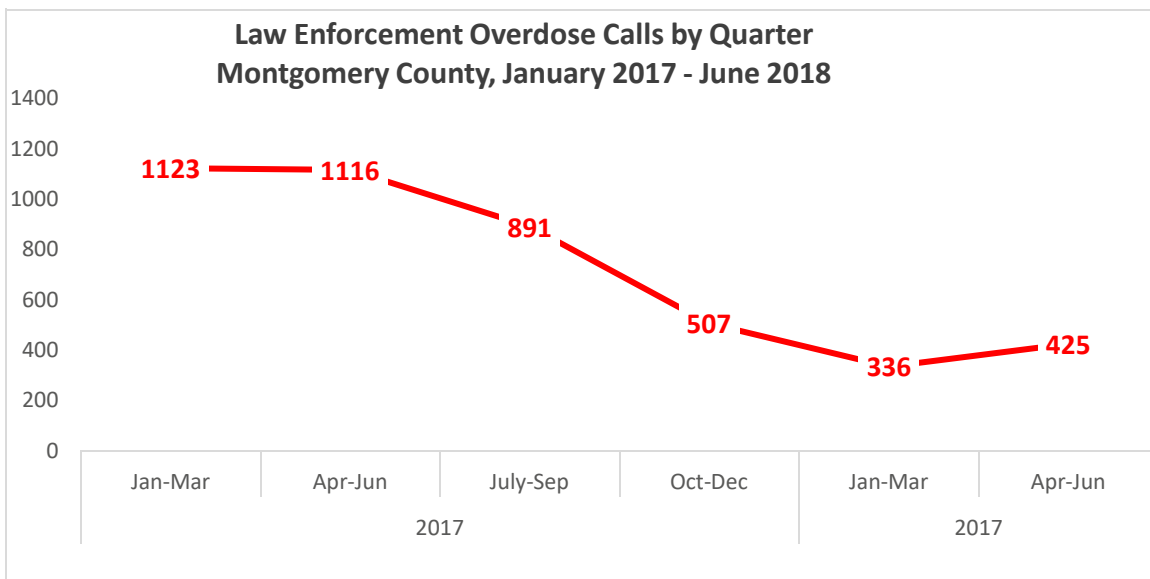

Law Enforcement Overdose Calls, January 1 – June 30

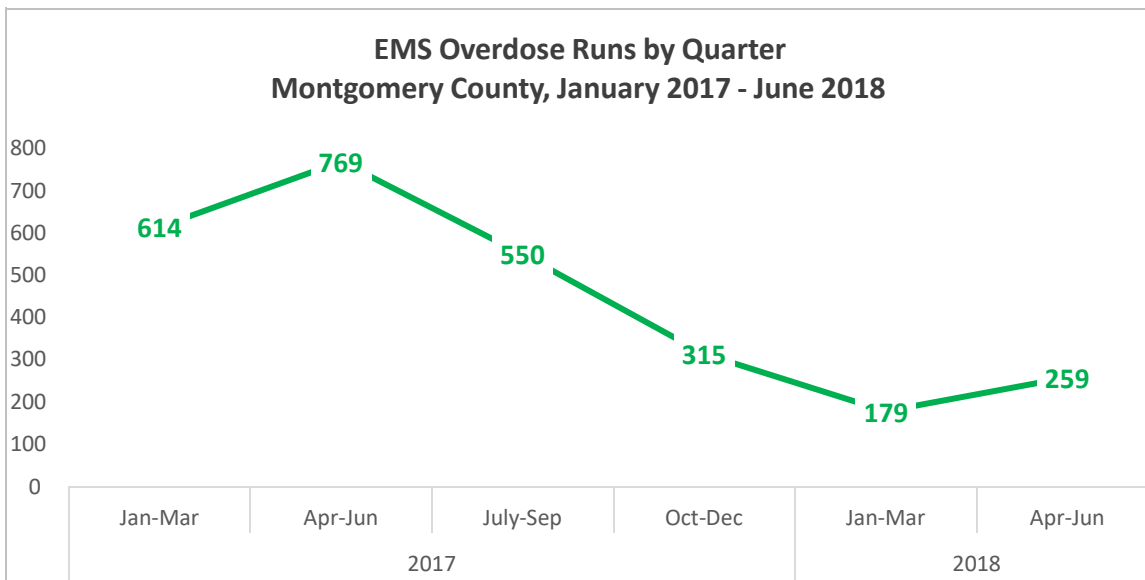

EMS Overdose Runs, January 1 – June 30

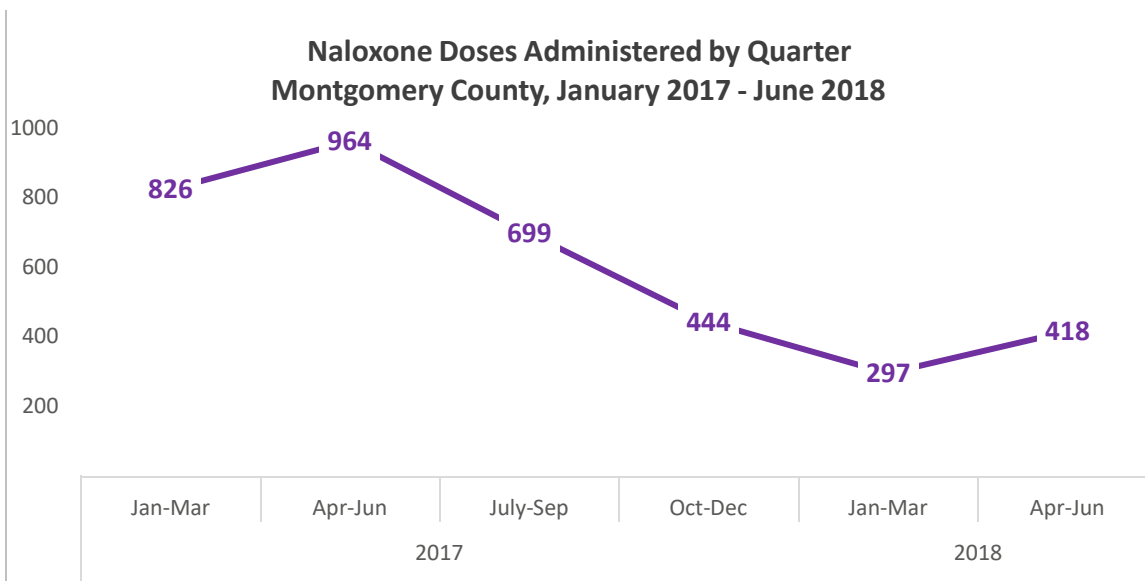
